ACT Health is offering a unique opportunity be part of an exciting pilot extended scope Physiotherapy project within the fields of Orthopaedic Outpatients and the Emergency Department. We are seeking highly qualified musculoskeletal physiotherapists with a minimum of 5 years post-graduate experience, 3 years specialising in a relevant musculoskeletal field and a relevant Clinical Masters. The Office of the Allied Health Advisor has been exploring these roles for the last 2 years in collaboration with the International Centre for Allied Health Evidence – as such the process has followed a strict evidence-based approach in the development of models of care and role definition.

The pilot roles will explore the effect that extending the scope of Physiotherapists will have on the efficiencies in healthcare delivery, clinical outcomes, patient and staff satisfaction and organisational outcomes.
